



## Communiqué – 2022 Fees

*Last updated: December 9, 2021*

The National Dental Hygiene Certification Board is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to delivering high quality examinations and testing for the profession. While we are committed to keeping our expenses low, we will increase our fees in 2022 to bring them in line with inflation at a rate of approximately 2.1%.

**NOTE:** *The National Dental Hygiene Certification Board and the Federation of Dental Hygiene Regulators of Canada have agreed to amalgamate on January 1, 2022. The new organization will operate as the Federation of Dental Hygiene Regulators of Canada from that date forward.*
