

Communique – Severe Weather May 21, 2022

On May 21, 2022, an extreme weather event passed through Southern Ontario and Eastern Quebec that left many individuals without power or internet.

The FDHRC understands that many of our Southern Ontario and Quebec candidates have been negatively affected by this extreme weather that hit the provinces and are concerned about their ability to write the NDHCE on May 24th and 25th.

The FDHRC has worked with Meazure Learning to confirm a rescheduled exam date for the May 2022 NDHCE for those individuals affected by the extreme weather this past weekend.

We are pleased to inform you that an alternative date has been confirmed to allow those affected to still write their exam in a timely manner.

IMPORTANT DETAILS FOR RESCHEDULING YOUR EXAM:

Rescheduled Date – Friday, June 3, 2022.

This was the first available date for rescheduling provided by Meazure Learning. It will be the only date available for candidates to reschedule their exam due to the storm.

If you have been impacted by the storm and wish to take the NDHCE on the alternative date, please respond to this email letting us know and we will communicate your information with Meazure Learning. Meazure Learning will then open a new booking session and you will receive a notice, via email, to book yourself into that new date. Note, you will not receive the rescheduled booking email until Thursday, May 26 so do not panic when you do not receive it right away.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - IF YOU STILL WANT TO WRITE YOUR EXAM AT YOUR REGULARLY SCHEDULED DATE AND TIME:

If you are in these areas but have not been negatively impacted by the storm and still want to write at your regularly scheduled date and time on May 24th or 25th – you do not need to do anything. No one is being automatically rescheduled. Your currently scheduled exam date and time are still valid, and you can write on the 24th and 25th. Only those who confirm they need to reschedule will have their exam moved.
